Aquatherm's PP-R has been carefully developed and refined over the last four decades to create the perfect pipe for your operation. Most piping manufacturers rely on outdated methods and materials just because it's familiar or cheaper, but not us.

At Aquatherm, we believe in doing things differently, just like you.

NOT JUST AN ALTERNATIVE

Aquatherm pipes are made from polypropylene-random (PP-R), a chemically inert thermoplastic that provides many benefits over other materials. So rather than just being an alternative, Aquatherm pipe is a serious upgrade while being quite competitive cost-wise.

Aquatherm pipe is completely inert and does not react with water or glycol, so it will never corrode in cooling systems. And it does not become brittle over time or fail when exposed to extreme temperatures.

FUTURE-PROOF SYSTEMS

Traditional piping materials use either foreign substances (glue, solder) or mechanical connections (gaskets, threads) to hold a system together, and these connections eventually fail.

Aquatherm pipes use heat fusion, a fast, reliable process that makes seamless, leak-free connections.

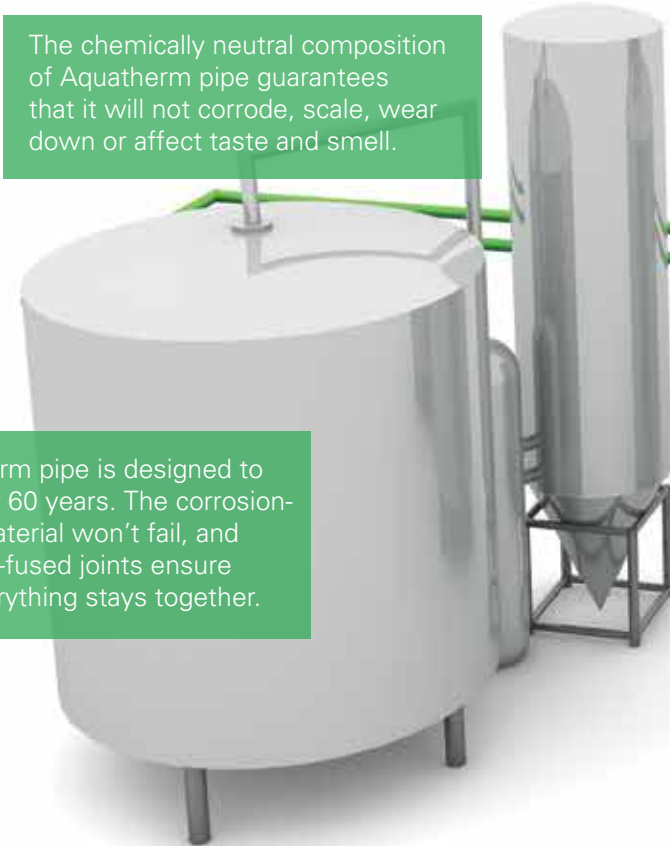

The chemically neutral composition of Aquatherm pipe guarantees that it will not corrode, scale, wear down or affect taste and smell.

Aquatherm pipe is designed to last over 60 years. The corrosion-proof material won't fail, and the heat-fused joints ensure that everything stays together.



Aquatherm pipe is stabilized for both high and low temperatures and is safe for use in almost any part of a system.



"Copper is more expensive, harder to work with, and it doesn't have a good R-value. Since PVC becomes really brittle when it gets cold, that was not a viable option for us either. We picked Aquatherm because of the insulation value and the ease of installation."

To form a connection, the material is melted, joined together, then allowed to cool. The materials become one, as if they came from our factory that way, so leaks and failures are a thing of the past.

To accommodate system expansion, Aquatherm has fusion outlets that can be added by drilling into the pipe and heat-fusing a fitting directly into the pipe wall.

Aquatherm can be used in most of your systems, giving you greater uniformity throughout the building. **Try Aquatherm for potable water, compressed air, product transfer, heating, cooling, and more.** And to show you how serious we are about our pipe, we back it with a 10-year manufacturer's warranty that covers replacement, personal injury, and even lost profits, up to roughly \$20 million per incident.
